- Projects where training would make a difference in the company's productivity, competitiveness, and ability to do business in New England

Who is eligible to apply ?

Training grants are direct grants awarded competitively to employers, employer organizations, labor organizations and training providers, to train current and new hired workers. Technical assistance grants are grant to help an employer, or a group of employers or employees determine a set of training needs.
